



2019 Whistle Belly Festival Supports Craft Beer and Community

WILLIAMSBURG, Va. — Combining their love of craft beer and the community, DoG Street Pub is once again teaming up with the Junior Woman's Club of Williamsburg (JWCW) for the fifth annual [Whistle Belly Festival](#).

The event will be held on Saturday, August 3 from 7 to 11 p.m. on the 400 Block of Duke of Gloucester Street right in the heart of Merchants Square. Due to increasing popularity, the event has been expanded and will now run from N. Nassau to N. Boundary Street.

The 2019 Whistle Belly Festival will host 45 breweries, 10 non-alcohol vendors, games, and multiple food stations. General admission is \$55 inclusive of food and drink. Tickets sales benefit local non-profits and scholarship opportunities via the Junior Women's Club of Williamsburg.

Whistle Belly will also offer VIP early admission starting at 6 p.m. Sponsored by the Raymond A. Mason School of Business – College of William and Mary, VIP tickets are \$75 to sample 10 exclusive beers in addition to the 80+ beers generally available.
